## SoIC Careers

### Career Fairs

Attending our career fairs is a great way to meet hundreds of potential employees. The School hosts two large career fairs each year; last fall, more than 1,100 job and internship seekers attended our fair.

### On-Campus Interviews

If you are looking to increase your visibility with students and have a more productive recruiting season, we encourage you to schedule on-campus interviews. We offer next-day interviews following each career fair and on-campus interviews later in the semester.

### Job Postings

Post full-time, internship, and part-time positions in SoIC Careers.

### Information Sessions

Information sessions are traditionally held the evening prior to an on-campus interview day to provide students with more information about your company.

### Tech Talks

Host a tech talk and speak to students about tech-related topics and industry trends, informing our students about the latest happenings of the tech world.
